Dear Saints,

We are pleased to announce the Southeast student conferences for Spring 2019. These will be held at the same location as the recent Fall conference at *Athens Y Camp*, in the mountains of North Georgia, 68 miles north of Athens. The junior high and high school conferences will be held on March 15-17, 2019.

This new location provides our students with an atmosphere free from distractions where they can give themselves wholly to pursue knowing what is on the Lord's heart. Regarding the Lord taking His disciples to the mountainous region of Caesarea Philippi in Matthew 16, Brother Lee said:

The Lord brought His disciples purposely to such a place with a clear atmosphere that their thought might be released from the effects of the religious surroundings in the holy city and holy temple, and that He might reveal to them something new concerning Himself and the church, which is the pulse of His heavenly kingdom. It was here that the vision concerning Him as the Christ and the Son of the living God came to Peter (vv. 16-17). It was also here that the church was revealed and mentioned for the first time as the means of bringing in the kingdom of the heavens (vv. 18-19). —Life-Study of Matthew, p. 562

One worker from each locality will register online for each conference and mail payment to the Church in Athens. All adults attending the junior high and high school conferences must complete a background check once every three years. More information is at seypw.org/bgcheck.html.

We also encourage parents of junior high and high school students to attend. We believe parents' coming with their sons and daughters will help blend our young people's family life and church life. The parents' presence will also provide the continuity that is needed in the spiritual experience of our young people and will allow more ground for the Lord to gain each household.

WHO MAY ATTEND Students in grades 7-12, their parents, and serving ones

FORMS Consecration and medical forms (available at seypw.org/medrelease.pdf) must be completed by all students and their parents and kept by a serving one during the conference.

REGISTRATION \$100 if paid by Lord's Day, March 3. Late registration is \$125 until Friday March 8. Students, parents, and serving ones must all register and pay the same fee for attending.

AND PAYMENT **After March 8, we will not accept registration and will not issue refunds.**

DEPARTURE The last conference meeting ends on Lord's Day at noon.

WHAT TO BRING

1. Recovery Version of the Bible with footnotes and hymnal.
2. Attire for the sanctified atmosphere (See guidelines in the consecration agreement).
3. This is a rustic camp. Bring all needed personal items: bedding, towel, toiletries, etc.

NOTE: The camp does NOT provide any towels or linens, so students and serving ones must bring their own bedding, pillow, towels, soap, etc.
